This report explains why accountability — not visibility — is the missing link in Snowflake cost governance, and how to build it systematically.

— UNDERSTANDING THE GAP

Visibility Is **Not** the Problem

Snowflake teams have never had more data about their cost. Yet the same expensive workloads, idle warehouses, and runaway queries appear in reports quarter after quarter. The culprit is not visibility — it's what happens after visibility.

The Snowflake ecosystem has no shortage of monitoring and observability tools. Teams can measure warehouse utilization, query execution history, user activity, and workload trends in remarkable detail.

Despite this, most organizations consistently report the same pattern: **dashboards improve, spending doesn't**. The reason is deceptively simple.

Optimization requires a complete operational cycle — from detection to resolution. Most programs invest heavily in the first stage and almost nothing in the remaining three. The result is a growing library of dashboards that describe problems nobody is accountable for fixing.

ROOT CAUSE

Organizations optimize for *finding* problems. Mature programs optimize for *proving they were fixed*.

This gap between **cost visibility** and **cost reduction** is what we call the **Snowflake Accountability Gap**.

— THREE SYMPTOMS OF THE ACCOUNTABILITY GAP

**SYMPTOM 1****Repeated Discoveries**

The same expensive workload appears in monthly reviews for 3, 6, or 12 consecutive months with no resolution, because each finding has no owner.

**SYMPTOM 2****Orphaned Workloads**

Expensive warehouses, dashboards, and pipelines run continuously with no clear owner — often because the original engineer has changed roles or left.

**SYMPTOM 3****Unverified Savings**

Optimization work gets done but never validated. The team believes they saved credits; the bill says otherwise. Nobody can demonstrate the outcome.

— THE ACCOUNTABILITY CYCLE

The 4-Stage Governance Framework

Sustainable Snowflake cost reduction follows a four-stage cycle. Most teams complete Stage 1. Organizations that consistently control costs complete all four — and use tooling to automate the transitions between stages.



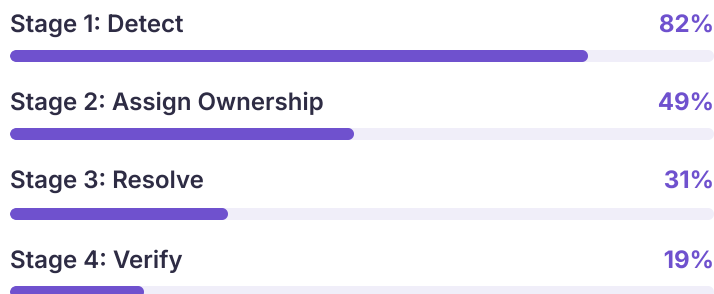
⚠ THE CRITICAL FAILURE POINT

Stage 2 — Assign Ownership — is where most programs collapse. Without a systematic way to route findings to accountable individuals, every discovery remains in a shared report that everyone has access to and nobody is required to act on.

The technical work of optimization (Stage 3) is well understood by most data engineering teams. The missing capability is the operational infrastructure that connects detection outputs to named, accountable individuals and tracks them to completion.

Organizations that close the accountability gap consistently achieve **40–60% reduction in repeat cost issues** within the first quarter of implementing formal ownership workflows.

STAGE COMPLETION RATES



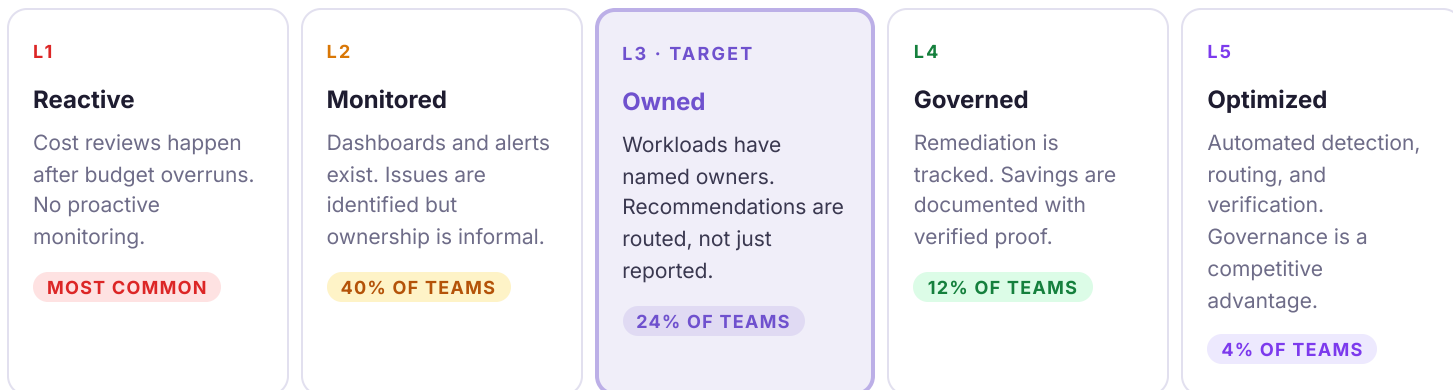

Moving to **systematic ownership** produces the highest marginal return — reducing repeat issues by an estimated **55%** within 90 days. This is the single highest-leverage transition most teams can make.
